

## Poster Board Guidelines

Present research or work done on Mental Health and Well-being initiatives for students. Posters can speak to an initiative, a program, a pilot project, an evaluation, or a review you participated in.

- The poster board should be approximately 36" tall and 48" wide and fit onto a tri-panel board (not provided) which will sit on rectangular tables.
- Include a title, the purpose, the process or methodology used, the general findings or outcomes, and next steps in content of poster board.
- Include your name, department (or work area), and name of board, organization, or entity.
- Include any handouts or other relevant resources you would like to share with conference attendees.
