- Development of an evaluation framework
- Monitor the administration of the data collection process
- Data analysis and reporting of evaluation outcomes

- Expertise related to policy and program evaluation (design, ethics, quantitative and qualitative analysis, reporting).
- Knowledge of R and RStudio considered an asset

- Excellent time management
- Ability to manage sensitive information and data from particular groups or at the system level.
- Interpersonal, consultation and oral/written communication skills, including proven ability to translate complex concepts for lay audiences
